The NSS Symbol

The National Service Scheme's symbol, which appears on the cover page, is based on the chariot wheel of Odisha's Konark Sun Temple. The Sun Temple's massive wheels represent the cycle of creation, preservation, and release, as well as the movement of life across time and space. The symbol's design, a simplified version of the sun-chariot wheel, emphasizes movement. The wheel represents life's ever-increasing cycle. It represents both continuity and change, implying the NSS's ongoing commitment to societal development and advancement.

About the NSS

The National Service Scheme (NSS) had its birth on September 24, 1969, during the Mahatma Gandhi centenary year. The scheme was first launched in 37 universities comprising 40,000 students. Today the NSS has become the largest Government organization of students in the country comprising members from the +2 level to the college and university levels. The strength of volunteers has now increased to more than 30 lakhs, which makes the NSS one of the largest student forces in the world. The number of students strength increased from 40,000 to over 3.8 million up to the end of March 2018 students in various universities,

colleges, and institutions of higher learning have volunteered to take part in various community service programs. The strength of NSS volunteers makes the NSS one of the largest student forces in the world.

The NSS has good relations with different government agencies and non-government organizations in implementing its programs for building up community assets and helping the underprivileged people through education and social services. 





3.FIRST AID AWARENESS PROGRAM

An First Aid awareness program on 3.08.2023 was organized with help of “Trichy orthopedic society” and the Dr.Terrance Olympia Hospital served as the resource person for the session. He commenced by outlining the objectives of first aid, elucidating the role of first aiders, and detailing incident management procedures. Demonstrations were provided for life-saving skills, including first aid protocols for dog, snake, and scorpion bites, as well as the DRABC (Danger Response Airway Breathing and Circulation) procedure used in cases of suspected serious injuries. Additionally, procedures for treating fractures, bleeding, and minor injuries were showcased. The session concluded with a demonstration of single, two, three, and four-way first aid transportation methods. A total of seventy-eight NSS volunteers from our college are participated in this enlightening program, which proved highly beneficial for all attendees.

5.VOTERS ENROLLMENT CAMP

Our college NSS team and the Kulathur Block of Pudukottai district collaborated to organize a voter registration camp on 25.09.2023 as part of the Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) activities, aiming to enhance youth participation in the upcoming 2024 Lok Sabha elections. The camp targeted students turning 18 years old on January 1, 2024, providing them with information on the voter helpline application's functionality to facilitate their inclusion in the voter list. The 'Voter Helpline' application, available for download from the Play Store, allows for new voter registrations under Form 6 and registrations for foreign residents under Form 6A. Additionally, Aadhaar and voter ID linking can be done through Form 6B, while the removal of names from the voter list for any reason and corrections can be made through Forms 7 and 8, respectively. Opportunities to add names to the voter list are provided for individuals turning 18 in the months of January, April, July, and October. Officials indicated that similar registration camps would be organized in more colleges to raise awareness among students about the election process. Over 80 students registered their names at the voter enrollment camp and received their voter identity cards in February 2024.

8.DRAWING COMPETITION FOR VOTER AWARENESS



10.HIV Awareness




