NSS SPECIAL CAMP REPORT

VENUE: VADAKUTHUVARAVAYAL

DATE : FEB 23 – 29, 2024

The NSS Special Camp was organized upholding the theme “*YOUTH FOR CLEAN INDIA*” at Vadakuthuvaravayal village by Unit-I & Unit-II during Feb 23 – 29, 2024.

A brief report on the Special Camp is detailed below;

On 23/02/2024, the inaugural functions was conducted in the camp site Mr. B. Abraham Ponsingh, the NSS program Officer, delivered the welcome address to the evening function. Mr. T. Selvam, District Councilor of Thuvaravayal, Mrs. Dhivya Suresh, Panchayat President, Mrs. A. Anjali Arumugam, Panchayat Vice-President, Mr. R. Saravana, Panchayat Secretary, Mr. D. Ravi, Chief Executive, Dr. P. Vasudevan, Director expressed their greetings to the NSS volunteers and program officers. Dr. R. Elagovan, Principal, graced the occasion and motivated the NSS volunteers for the efficient conduct of the Special Camp, which will develop the organizational capability of the NSS volunteers.

During the camp, the volunteers organized various programmes like lecture, drama, skit and cultural events to create awareness among the villagers on the special camp theme “Youth for Clean India”.

The NSS volunteers also exhibited their creative and cultural talents through various “THEME – *ORIENTED CULTURAL PROGRAMMES*” like De-addiction of Alcoholic Habits, Organic Agriculture, Awareness on Environmental Pollution and Community Harmony and awareness on consumer at the village almost all the evenings during the 7-day Special Camp.

Day 1

On first day, 23rd February 2024, the volunteers visited the villagers' homes and studied their living style, food habits and created awareness on hygienic practices through interactions with their family members. The people of the Vadaku Thuvaravayal village were explained the causes of communicable diseases and preventive measures. The villagers also were instructed how to be 'healthy and hale' through best hygienic practices, food habits and environmental cleanliness. Our NSS volunteers clean the places which they are accommodate and plastics were eradicated in the camp venue.

Day 2

On 24th of February 2024, the second day of the camp, **Mr.S.Vigneshwaran, a Yoga trainer**, provided **yoga training** to the NSS volunteers and the villagers. Yoga trainer elaborated the importance of physical, mental and physiological health. His session exposed the students to the basics of yoga including suryanamaskaar and pranayama.

After the yoga training NSS volunteers were divided into two groups and sent to their designated village areas- Vadaku Thuvaravayal to convey the information regarding the Veterinary medical camp the next day.

On evening the programme on "**HIV awareness and blood donation**" was organized at the special camp venue. **Mr.Paranthaman** was the resource person on the occasion. He explained about various pleasurable moments enjoyed in his life and the village life molded him to be a mentor of student community. And also shared the importance and need of blood donation among students.

Day 3

On February 25, 2024, volunteers set up the "Veterinary Medical Camp" at the camp site. 39 goats and 4 cows were medicated by a team of doctors under the head of **Dr.Kamalakannan** from the Govt Veterinary Hospital in Keeranur, who conducted the camp, diagnosed various cattle, and gave the necessary medications to the cattle owned by the residents of Vadaku Thuvravayal village. The villagers expressed their gratitude for the camp and suggested that it become an annual event. The students were exposed to the nuances and richness of country life. Evening the cultural program was conducted by NSS volunteers and village children's.

Day 4

On February 26, 2024, the NSS volunteers organized a **parade** at the camp venue to mark the importance of camp. The parade was the formation of volunteer group whose movement is restricted by close order maneuvering for reiterating the theme of Youth for Clean India. The parade was held with very strict formation so as to maximize their effectiveness. During parade, the volunteers have restricted movement.

Then the students were divided into two groups and sent to their designated village areas Vadaku Thuvravayal to convey the information regarding the Eye camp the next day.

Evening the awareness programme on “Role of NSS Volunteers in society” was organized at the special camp venue, **Prof.N.Kanagaraj**, Assistant Professor, Dept. of ECE, was the resource person on the occasion. He explained that the youth must have good qualities to develop a society and render the service for the upliftment of socially downtrodden people. His insightful ideas inspired our NSS volunteers to take part in this wonderful initiative.

Day 5

On February 27, 2024, A free eye camp organized for the benefit of Vadaku Thuvravayal village people. Eye camp was conducted with “**THE EYE FOUNDATION, TRICHY**”. The eye camp was conducted with the objective to promote eye health among the people. A six-member medical team including a doctor and nurses were engaged in this camp. A total of 100 people were benefited from this eye screening camp and children with minor problems, like trouble in reading (eye-sight) and itchy eyes, were given appropriate suggestion for further examination. The event was regularly managed by our NSS volunteers.

On evening the programme on “**AWARENESS FOR CONSUMER**” was organized at the special camp venue at 6pm. **Mr.G.Karthick**, Assistant Professor, Dept. of EEE, was the resource person on the occasion. He explained that the need of consumer awareness for buying commodities. The programme was very useful for NSS volunteers.

Day 6

On February 28, 2024, the “**TREE PLANTATION PROGRAMME**” was organized at the special camping sites. About 200 saplings were distributed free of cost to the residents

of Vadaku Thubaravayal villagers. The volunteers exhorted the villagers to nurture the saplings using scientific methods. This programme is noteworthy which was well-appreciated by the villagers.

On evening the “**ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME**” was organized for volunteers and villagers at the camp. **Mr. Ranjith Kumar**, Research Associate, NIT, Trichy was the Chief Guest on the occasion. He explained about water harvesting and methods involved for creating the sustainable environment for saving future generation. At the end of the programme, the villagers and students clarified their doubts by interacting with the speaker. He also explained that agriculture is the cultivation and breeding of animals, plants, etc., which are the key development area in the human civilization. Agriculture is the broad economic sector, which is declining in its contribution to the GDP. Now organic farming is an alternative agricultural system, which relies on organic fertilizer such as compost, green manure, bone meal etc. This programme was well-appreciated by the villagers.

Day 7

On February 29, 2024, the sports events were conducted for school students at the adopted village and distributed prizes to the winners of the competitions. NSS volunteers **conducted competitions for the kids** in the village. The huge turnout saw active participation from students across age groups. They were divided into 3 teams. LKG, UKG as group A, Classes 1-2 as Group B, class 3-4 as Group C, classes 5-6 as Group D, Classes 7-8 Group E, Class 9 as separate group. The kids enthusiastically participated in games lemon and spoon, filling the bottle and bursting the balloons. The kids assembled much earlier than the stipulated time, it was a mark of their rapport with the NSS volunteers and the excitement of competition.

Mr. Gandhi and Mr. Lenin from Kajamalai magalir mandram conducted an awareness program on “**DRUGS OR NARCOTICS ERADICATION THROUGH RURAL ART PERFORMANCES**” for the NSS volunteers and the villagers.

The Valedictory Function was held around 6pm evening. Mr.R.Karthick, the NSS program organizer, delivered the welcome address. Mr.T.Selvam, District Councilor of Melapudthuvayal, Mrs.Dhivya Suresh, Panchayat President, Mrs.A.Anjali Arumugam, Panchayat Vice-President, Mr.R.Saravanan, Panchayat Secretary, Mr.D.Ravi, Chief

Executive, Dr.P. Vasudevan, Director, and Dr.R.Elagovan, Principal who in his valedictory address appreciated the NSS Volunteers for their active participation and performance. The special chief guest Dr.B. Kumargurubaran, NSS Zonal co ordinator, Anna University, Trichy, delivered a wonderful speech to the students. Mr.Rahumathullah, NSS volunteer gave the vote of thanks.

The Special Camp was thus successfully concluded, which was very useful for the people of Vadaku Thuravayal village.








